FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

WHEN AND WHERE WILL THE CEREMONY BE HELD?

The ceremony will be held on **Wednesday, July 9, 2025** at Arizona Financial Theatre, which is located at 400 W. Washington St., Phoenix, AZ 85003. For more information about the ceremony, visit our [GRADUATION PAGE](#).

HOW DO I GET MY CAP, GOWN AND TASSEL?

Graduation caps, gowns and tassels can be purchased through Josten's directly, from now until **May 31st**. Ordering information is sent to all graduates when they complete their final courses with Primavera. Caps & gowns are on sale now.

Orders placed **AFTER May 31st** will be through Primavera directly, for **\$55** through **June 27th**. Items can be picked up at the Primavera office in Chandler until Thursday, **July 3rd**. After that date all orders will have to be picked up on the day of the ceremony during student check-in.

WHEN WILL GRADUATES NEED TO ARRIVE?

Graduates will need to arrive at **9:00^{am}** or **1:00^{pm}** to **begin the check-in** process on **Graduation Day**. Check-in will run from **9^{am} - 10^{am}** or **1^{pm} - 2^{pm}** and all students **MUST CHECK IN** before being cleared to walk in the ceremony. Students who have not received their caps and gowns may pick up these items during check-in.

HOW LONG IS THE CEREMONY?

The ceremony is expected to take **1 –1.5 hours**.

WHERE SHOULD I PARK?

Guests are encouraged to find parking at one of the many garages, metered street parking or aboveground lots in the arena. For more information, see the attached map.

WHERE IS CHECK IN?

Students will check in on the East side of the Arizona Financial Theatre. Student check-in will be marked with a-frame signage.

WHAT TIME WILL DOORS BE OPEN TO GUESTS?

Doors will open to guests **EXACTLY 1 HOUR BEFORE** the ceremony begins. At **10^{am} for the 11^{am} ceremony** and **2^{pm} for the 3^{pm} ceremony**, the main doors to the arena will open and parents/family/guests will be able to enter, check in, and take their seats.

HOW MANY STUDENTS WILL PARTICIPATE IN THE CEREMONY?

Approximately 500–600 graduates are expected to participate in the ceremony.

WHAT SHOULD I WEAR?

Graduates should wear business casual attire.

Men's' suggested attire: slacks, a button-down shirt, dress shoes and optional tie.

Ladies' suggested attire: dress, slacks or skirt with a dress shirt and dress shoes. Please note that heels must be under three inches, and dresses or skirts must at least reach your thumbs when your arms are completely extended down to your side.

Students will be walking up and down some steps, so plan accordingly!

WILL I RECEIVE MY DIPLOMA AT THE CEREMONY?

Yes. Depending on your last date of attendance, you will have the option to receive your diploma and diploma cover at graduation. Otherwise, it will be mailed to you, or you can pick it up from our Chandler office.

ARE NAMES READ IN ALPHABETICAL ORDER?

No, names are read as graduates cross the stage based on the order in which they are seated. A-L will be seated on one half of the lower bowl and M-Z will be seated on the other half so parents/guests know "roughly" where graduates will be seated.

FREE APPLICATION FOR FEDERAL STUDENT AID (FAFSA)

What is it?

This free application is used by colleges to determine your eligibility for financial aid from the federal government, including grants, unsubsidized/subsidized student loans and work-study programs. The FAFSA is your first and most important step to getting the money you need to help you pay for college.

Who is it for?

Anyone! You don't need to be accepted at a school before you can submit your FAFSA. You only need to list the schools to which you have applied.

Where can I find my FAFSA?

Online applications are available at studentaid.gov.

When should I apply?

ASAP. ASAP. The sooner you submit your application, the more likely you are to receive financial aid. If you are planning to attend college during the 2025-2026 school year, the federal deadline for online applications is June 29, 2025.
